**Re: Notice of 2025 Cruise Fee amendments**

The Vancouver Fraser Port Authority has approved the following cruise fee amendments that will take effect on January 1, 2025:

1. **Passenger Fees: 3.9% (2023 CPI) increase from 2024 Fees**
  - a) Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday: increase by \$0.76 to \$20.10 per passenger.
  - b) Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday: increase by \$0.73 to \$19.31 per passenger.
2. **Services and Facilities Fees: 3.9% (2023 CPI) increase from 2024 Fees**
  - a) Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday: increase by \$1.65 to \$44.15 x length of vessel (in metres) for the first 12-hour period or portion thereof.
  - b) Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday: increase by \$1.59 to \$42.26 x length of vessel (in metres) for the first 12-hour period or portion thereof.
3. **Cruise Terminal Fresh Water Supply Fee: 3.9% (2023 CPI) increase from 2024 Fees**  
Cruise Terminal Fresh Water Supply Fee: increase by \$0.09 to a rate of \$2.43 per tonne.
