Re: **Goodrich Terminals – Project Permit No. 18-037 Lumber Transload Facility and Rail Spur Amendment 02 - Extension**

The Vancouver Fraser Port Authority (the “Port Authority”) has received a request from Goodrich Terminals, to amend the expiry date of Project Permit PER No. 18-037 from December 31, 2022 to June 30, 2023. The Port Authority understands that the request is a result of project scheduling delays as more time is required to obtain additional approvals, before these specific works commence. The remaining scope of works include the installation of the rail spur, approximately 355 metres in length, and modifications to flood control infrastructure to accommodate the rail spur.

The Port Authority has undertaken and completed a review of the requested amendment in accordance with the *Canada Marine Act*, section 5 of the Port Authorities Operations Regulations, and section 82 of the *Impact Assessment Act*, as applicable.

Accordingly, the Port Authority authorizes an amendment to Project Permit PER No. 18-037 to extend the expiry date; the expiry date for this permit is now June 30, 2023.
